| Objectives of the Practice                  | To teach post graduate students to run obstetric emergency drills<br>To help evaluate and improve their responses to obstetric<br>emergencies.  |
| The Context                                 | It is a method for practicing the management of an obstetric<br>emergency in facilities where emergency obstetric care is delivered   |
| The Practice                                | The trainers clarify to the participants (health providers who will assist the obstetrics client) that the measures to be taken with the obstetrics client should be real up to a certain limit (invasive procedures simulated, not done). The drill ends when the obstetrics client has been treated and a clinical outcome has been reached |
| Evidence of Success                         | The post graduate students are confidently managing the emergency obstetric cases in labour room  |
| Problems Encountered and Resources Required | Exact simulation of the real time environment may not always be practically possible. Repeated drills are required to prepare the residents to deal with real time situations.  |
