- 1) Attendance requirements are 75% in theory & 80% Practical/Clinical for eligibility to appear for the examination in that subject. In subjects that are taught in more than one phase-the learner must have 75% attendance in theory and 80% in practical in each phase of instruction in that subject.
- 2) If an examination comprises more than one subject (for e.g., General Surgery and allied branches), the candidate must have minimum of 75% attendance in each subject including its allied branches separately and 80% attendance in each clinical posting. Attendance of 80% in FAP is mandatory.
- 3) An end of posting clinical assessment shall be conducted for each clinical posting in each professional year

- Student doctor method followed in clinical postings:**
 The learner will function as a part of the health care team with the following responsibilities:
1. Be part of the unit's outpatient services on admission days.
 2. Remain with the admission unit until 6 PM except during designated class hours.
 3. Be assigned patients admitted during each admission day for whom he/she will undertake responsibility, under the supervision of a senior resident or faculty member.
 4. Participate in the unit rounds on its admission day and will present the assigned patients to the supervising physician.
 5. Follow the patient's progress throughout the hospital stay until discharge.
 6. Participate, under supervision, in procedures, surgeries, deliveries etc. of assigned patients.
 7. Participate in unit rounds on at least one other day of the week excluding the admission day.
 8. Discuss ethical and other humanitarian issues during unit rounds.
 9. Attend all scheduled classes and educational activities.
