#### Note:

- 1. Ragging is punishable under law with fine/imprisonment/rustication from the University.
- **2.** Teaching areas of the College, including Library are declared as "Mobile Free & Smoking Zone". Any violation is punishable.
- **3.** The institute follows strict security measures for the safety of students. Students are expected to follow the rules. Any violation of the rules attracts disciplinary measures.
- **4.** Keep the campus clean. Use bins. This is a plastic free campus.

#### Note:

- 1. There shall be a minimum of 75% attendance in theory and 80% attendance in practical /clinical for eligibility to appear for the examinations in that subject. In subjects that are taught in more than one phase the learner must have 75% attendance in theory and 80% attendance in practical in each phase of instruction in that subject. There shall be a minimum of 75% attendance in AETCOM and minimum of 80% attendance in family visits under Family adoption programme. Each student shall adopt minimum 3 families/ households and preferably five families. The details shall be as per Family Adoption Program guidelines.
- 2. If an examination comprises more than one subject (for e.g., General Surgery and allied branches), the candidate must have a minimum of 75% attendance in each subject including its allied branches, and 80% attendance in each clinical posting.
- **3.** Learners who do not have at least 75% attendance in the electives will not be eligible for the Third Professional Part II examination/ NExT.
- 4. Learners must have completed the required certifiable competencies for that phase of training and completed the log book appropriate for that phase of training to be eligible for appearing at the final university examination of that subject.
- Learners must secure at least 50% of the total marks (combined in theory and practical / clinical; and minimum 40% in theory and practical separately) for internal assessment in a particular subject in order to be eligible for appearing at the final University examination of that subject.
